FOAL CLASSES

Class 1 - MOOR BRED FOAL - filly or colt born 2020 (Best Filly and Colt qualify for the foal championship after class 2)

Class 2 - UPCOUNTRY BRED FOAL - filly or colt born 2020 (Best filly and colt qualify for the foal championship after class 2)

FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP -Best filly and colt from class 1 and class 2. Sash for champion and reserve champion.

Champion and Reserve to compete in the Supreme championship immediately after the Youngstock Championship is completed.

To run on immediately afterwards.

YOUNGSTOCK CLASSES

Class 3 - YEARLING - Born 2019 (Highest placed male and highest placed female to qualify for the championship after class 5) Colts to be bitted

Class 4 - TWO YEAR OLD -Born 2018 (Highest placed male and highest placed female to qualify for the championship after class 5) All to be bitted and colt/stallion discs worn

Class 5 - THREE YEAR OLD- Born 2017 (Highest placed male and highest placed female to qualify for the championship after class 5) All to be bitted and colt/stallion discs worn

YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP - Highest placed male and highest placed female from classes 3,4 and 5 to compete. Champion and Reserve to compete in the supreme Championship held immediately afterwards.

SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP - for Champion and Reserve Foal and Champion and Reserve Youngstock.

RULES

1. The Exmoor Pony Centre (MMT) or ECHO do not accept liability for any loss of property or any accident or damage to any animal, vehicle, spectator or exhibitor, and all the entries are accepted subject to this condition.
2. Competitors and owners MUST have their own third-party public liability insurance.
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. All ponies to have been wormed at least 5 days prior to the event.
5. All lone competitors must report to the Secretary and provide an emergency contact number.
6. No child under 16 years of age may compete without an accompanying adult.
7. Colts/Stallions may only be handled by experienced and competent people over the age of 14 years.
8. Ponies should not be tied to horse boxes or trailers and horses/ponies should never be left unattended.
9. All children under 16 years of age must wear hard hats when handling ponies. Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times.
10. All gates must be kept closed at all times.
11. Well behaved dogs on short leads are welcome, however any disruptive behaviour may result in the owner being asked to remove the dog from the venue.
12. Spectators and other pedestrians must take care when negotiating the Pony Centre and use pedestrian walkways and viewing areas where provided, children must be supervised at all times. Non competitors must not enter the collecting area.
13. First aid provision is situated in the viewing area of the Pony Centre, first aiders can be contacted by the organising team. All accidents and injuries must be reported to the Exmoor Pony Centre Office and logged in the accident book. In case of emergency call 999.
